Set on hills looking south over the ancient Romney marsh down to the English channel, our land has the perfect geography and climate to produce the highest quality grapes and the finest English sparkling wine. Our wines are carefully hand-crafted to express the characteristics of each individual season.

VINTAGE

The 2016 growing season in Kent started early, and the weather during the summer months was relatively cool up until mid August when we recorded record temperatures in Kent, this late burst of warmth meant we were able to get the fruit to the desired levels of ripeness.

VINEYARD

Location: Woodchurch Vineyard, Kent

Soils: Clay loam on south facing slopes.

Microclimate: Warm and dry with close proximity to the coast.

Pruning method: Double guyot

Harvest period: October

Harvest method: Hand picked



WINEMAKING

Processing: Whole bunch pressed.

Lees aging: Minimum 18 months

Cork ageing: Minimum 3 months

TASTING NOTES

Rose gold in colour with aromas of elderflower and pear, the wine is bursting with flavours of strawberries, tangerines and apricots with a refreshing zesty finish. The perfect party aperitif and a great accompaniment to fish or chicken.
