Set on hills looking south over the ancient Romney marsh down to the English channel, our land has the perfect geography and climate to produce the highest quality grapes and the finest English sparkling wine. VINTAGE

The weather throughout the 2014 growing season was excellent. An early spring and warm summer gave the grapes longer to ripen on the vine, producing wines with greater depth and intensity.

VINEYARD

Location: Woodchurch Vineyard, Kent

Soils: Clay loam on south facing slopes.

Microclimate: Warm and dry with close proximity to the coast.

Pruning method: Double guyot

Harvest period: October

Harvest method: Hand picked

WINEMAKING

Processing: Whole bunch pressed.

Lees aging: Minimum 30 months

Cork ageing: Minimum 3 months

TASTING NOTES

Tasting Notes: This wine is fresh and elegant, yellow gold in colour and has aromas of pears and almonds. There are refreshing apple and butter flavours on the palate and a beautifully long citrus lime finish. This wine is a great aperitif and also the perfect accompaniment to seafood.
